58. SHINY DAISY-BUSH

Olearia TENUIFOLIA – Blue flowers in Winter and Spring.

59. FUZZY BOX

Eucalyptus conica - Confined to a small area in the Weddin Mountains.

60. HICKORY WATTLE

Acacia implexa - Cream flowers in Summer.

61. GREY BOX

Eucalyptus microcarpa - A good nectar producing tree, for honey.

62. WILLOW WATTLE

Acacia stenophylla - Very hard, close grained timber.

63. BROOMBUSH SHEOAK

Allocasuarina-diminuta - The seeds of this plant are the main diet of the Glossy Black Cockatoo.

31. CREEPING SALTBUSH

Rhagodia spinescens - A useful forage plant.

64. STREAKED WATTLE

Acacia lineata - Bushy shrub, yellow flowers in Spring.

65. GARGALOO

Parsonia eucalyptophylla - Climber, with sweet fragrant yellow flowers in Summer to Autumn.

66. SHRUBBY PLATYSACE

Platysace lanceolata - White flowers in Spring to Autumn.

Stypantra glauca - Blue flowers on 1 metre long stems, Spring.

79. HAIRY WATTLE

Acacia vestita - Showy wattle with grey leaves, yellow flowers.

80. KNIFE-LEAF WATTLE

Acacia cultriformis - Yellow flowers Spring - early Summer.

Rhagodia spinescens - A useful forage plant.

1. MAT-RUSH

Lomandra longifolia - Once used as temporary bootlace.

82. GREY RAY FLOWER

Cyphanthera albicans – Cream flowers with purple streaks.

83. BELAH

Casuarina cristata - Good shade tree.

84. FIVE CORNERS

Styphelia triflora - Cream tubular flowers & edible fruit.

85. BLUE DAMPIERA

Dampiera purpurea - Small shrub with blue flowers.

86. ROSY HONEY MYRTLE

Melaleuca diosmatifolia - Pinkish flowers in Spring - Summer.

87. HEATH MYRTLE

Sannantha cunninghamii - Small shrub with white flowers in Spring.

88. NARDOO

Marsilea drummondii - Once used by Aborigines to make bread.

89. CREEK BOTTLE BRUSH

Callistemon sieberi - Pale pink to cream flowers in Spring.

90. STELLARIA

Stellaria angustifolia - Ground cover with white flowers.

91. BLACKTHORN

Bursaria spinosa - White flowers in Summer.

Eucalyptus Sideroxylon—Hardwood Timber

2. MUDGEE or GLORY WATTLE

Acacia Spectabilis—Golden Flowers, Spring

3. BURRAWANG

Macrozamia Secunda—Vey Ancient Cycad

4. SARSPARILLA

Hardenbergia Violacea—An original plant from this site

5. QUANDONG

Santalum Acuminatum—Edible fruit, pie filling or jam

6. WAXFLOWER

Philotheca Myoporides—Pink starry flowers, spring

7. GRASS TREE

Xanthorrhoea Australis

8. WESTERN GOLDEN WATTLE

Acacia decora - An original plant from this site.

9. EGG & BACON

Dillwynia sericea - Red & yellow pea-flowers in Spring.

10. AMULLA

Eremophila debilis - White star shaped flowers & pink fruit.

11. SPUR - WING WATTLE

Acacia triptera - New growth pink to reddish.

12. GREY BUSH-PEA

Pultenaea spinosa - Orange-Red pea-flowers in Spring.

13. FINGER FLOWER

Cheiranthra cyanea - Violet flowers with prominent yellow anthers.

14. HEATH MYRTLE

Micromyrtus ciliata - Minute white flowers age to red.

15. BENT-LEAF WATTLE

Acacia flexifolia - Small winter flowering wattle.

16. DWYER'S MALLEE

Eucalyptus dwyeri - Mallee with creamy-white flowers.

17. TUMBLEDOWN RED GUM

Eucalyptus dealbata - An original plant from this site.

18. INDIGO

Indigofera australis - Once used for making ink.

19. SEVEN DWARFS GREVILLEA

Grevillea floribunda - Brown woolly flowers.

20. HILL GREVILLEA

Grevillea polybractea - Yellow-orange woolly flowers.

21. FAN GREVILLEA

Grevillea ramosissima - Holly-like leaves & cream flowers.

8. WESTERN GOLDEN WATTLE

Acacia decora - An original plant from this site.

22. FLAX LILY

Dianella revoluta - An original plant from this site.

23. NATIVE PELARGONIUM

Pelargonium australe - Pink flowers Spring & Summer.

24. CRYPTANDRA

Cryptandra amara - White to pink flowers Winter & Spring.

25. STICKY WALLABY BUSH

Beyeria viscosa - Small yellowish flowers, without petals.

26. SMALL CROWEA

Crowea exalata - Deep pink star-like flowers in Winter.

27. SHOWY INDIGO

Indigofera adesmifolia - Purple pea flowers in Spring.

10. AMULLA

Eremophila debilis - White star flowers & Pink fruit.

4. SARSPARILLA

Hardenbergia violacea - Climber with pea flowers.

28. SCRIBBLY GUM

Eucalyptus rossii - Scribbles on bark are made by a moth larva.

29. GRENPELL GREVILLEA

Grevillea lanigera (Grenfell form) - Beautiful small Grevillea, yet to be brought into cultivation. Deep Pink & Cream flowers Winter & Spring.

30. MINT BUSH

Prostanthera ovalifolia (Brundah Form) Largest natural stand occurs in the Grenfell District. Comes in many colour forms.

31. CREEPING SALTBUSH

Rhagodia spinescens - A useful forage plant.

32. GOODENIA

Goodenia glabra - Ground cover with yellow flowers.

33. EARLY WATTLE

Acacia genistifolia - Original plant, with cream flowers early Spring.

34. BROAD-LEAF HOPBUSH

Dodonaea viscosa - Red or purplish fruit in Summer.

35. VIOLET KUNZEA

Kunzea parvifolia - Violet, pink flowers in late Spring.

36. SMOOTH DARLING PEA

Swainsona galegifolia - Brick red flowers in Spring.

22. FLAX LILY

Dianella revoluta - An original plant from this site.

37. SOUTHERN SENNA

Senna aciphylla - Deep yellow flowers in Spring.

38. MANY-FLOWERED MAT-RUSH

Lomandra multiflora - Yellowish flowers in Spring.

39. HOVEA

Hovea linearis - Purple, blue pea-flowers in Spring.

40. BEARDED HEATH

Leucopogon microphyllus - Small shrub with small white flowers.

41. SILKY GEEBUNG

Persoonia rigida - Yellow flowers & edible fruit.

42. CURRAWANG or BRIGALOW

Acacia doratoxylon - Highly perfumed timber & flowers.

67. VARNISH WATTLE

Acacia verniciflua - shiny young foliage yellow flower.

43. WONGA VINE

Pandorea pandorana - Climber with cream flowers spotted red inside.

22. FLAX LILY

Dianella revoluta - An original plant from this site.

44. STRINGY BARK

Eucalyptus macrorhyncha - Timber is highly regarded.

45. PRICKLY HAKEA

Hakea sericea - Pink or white flowers in Spring.

46. GARLAND LILY

Calostemma purpureum - White, yellow, pink or red flowers in summer

47. ROCK ISOTOMA

Isotoma axillaris - Blue star-like flowers, Spring & Summer.

48. KANGAROO THORN

Acacia paradoxa. Can be grown as a hedge plant.

2. MUDGEE or GLORY WATTLE

Acacia spectabilis - Golden flowers in Spring.

49. KURRAJONG

Brachychiton populneus - Good shade & fodder tree.

50. MYALL

Acacia pendula - Good shade tree. Grey weeping foliage.

51. SAGO BUSH

Ozothamnus diosmifolius - Flowers used in flower arrangements.

52. BUTTER BUSH

Pittosporum angustifolium. Cream fragrant flowers,orange fruit.

43. WONGA VINE

Pandorea pandorana - Climber,Cream flowers,spotted red inside.

53. SILVER SENNA

Senna artemisioides - Silver foliage, yellow flowers in Spring.

46. GARLAND LILY

Calostemma purpureum - Bulb with white, yellow,pink or red flowers in Summer after rain.

54. BLUE BELL

Wahlenbergia stricta - An original plant from this site.

31. CREEPING SALTBUSH

Rhagodia spinescens - A useful forage plant.
